

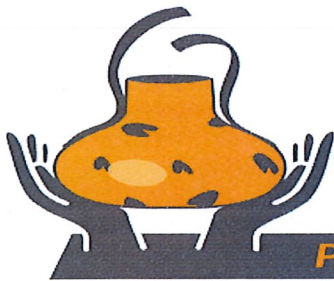
TVET SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2026

 4. Automotive Engineering
- ✓ Criteria for selection is course interest and financial need of the applicant.
- ✓ Eligible students for the TVET Scholarship 2026 are those who sat the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Examination (KCSE) in the years of 2022,2023 & 2024 and attained a mean grade of D & D+.
- ✓ Interested students who wish to apply for the scholarship will need to submit the following documents: -
 - (i) Certified copies of: -
 - (a) KCSE results' slip
 - (b) Secondary school leaving certificate.
 - (ii) Duly filled application form to Konoin TTI (for Bomet County) and Belgut TTI (for Kericho County).
 - (iii) Duly filled Scholarship application form (incomplete forms will not be considered).
- ✓ Canvassing will lead to automatic disqualification.

 - (d) Other confirmed sponsorships to the applicant
 - (e) Females and PLWD are encouraged to apply.
